Step 1

Open the website of the Identity Management Portal of the RUB.

Step 2

Log in with your RUB LoginID, the corresponding password and the security code from your app.

Step 3

You are now logged in to the RUB Identity Management Portal. Click on "2-Faktor-Authentifizierung (2-factor Authentication)".

You are now on the page with the heading "2-Faktor-Authentifizierung verwalten (Manage 2-Factor Authentication)". On this page, you can now remove your old smartphone. In the right column "Geräteinformationen (Device information)", click on the wastebin symbol next to your mobile device. You will be automatically logged out and can register a new device the next time you log in.
